Dear Parents,

Greetings from Principal's Desk!!

As your ward enters Senior Secondary Education Scheme, it is important to apprise you of the changes in the Examination and Evaluation to be followed in Class XI.

General Rules/ Conditions

1. **Class XI-** Examinations shall be conducted internally by the school. There will be no external examination for any subject.
2. The examination would be conducted for theory as well as for practical during Term End Exams only. However, only theory exam will be conducted during CT – I, II & III respectively.
3. In accordance with CBSE guidelines a minimum of 75% attendance is to be ensured in both the terms.

Promotion Policy for Class XI

- * Assessment year will have three Cycle Tests and two Term Exams. Term I will have CT-1 and a Term End Exam-I and Term II will have CT-2, CT-3 and Final Term End Exam.
- * The syllabus for all the CT's and Term End Exam would be informed to the students in advance.
- * The qualifying marks in each subject shall be 33%. However in a subject involving practical work a student must obtain 33% marks in theory as well as in practical separately, in addition to 33% marks in aggregate, in order to qualify in that subject.
- * Examination would be conducted for the five main subjects except Physical and Health Education and General Studies which will be assessed by the school according to the yearly performance of a student.
- * Evaluation of the five main subjects would be based on nine-point scale grading and General Studies and Physical and Health Education would be based on five-point scale grading
- * All the Cycle Tests and Term Exams are mandatory and will be assessed for the promotion to Class XII.

Weightage given to tests and term exams would be as follows :-

- * The Term End Exam of Term-II will be based on the entire syllabus.
- * According to CBSE, a candidate must obtain aggregate 33% marks in all five subjects separately in order to get promoted to class XII.
- * TEE consist of Theory and Practical assessment and it is compulsory to pass separately with 33% marks in both **Theory and Practical Examination.**
- * **Promotion Policy:** To qualify for class XII student need to secure **33% overall in each subject** as well as **33% in Annual Examination.** (The 33% in Theory and Practical separately, the two are not taken together.)
- * **Re-Assessment** – If a student secures less than 33% marks overall and less than 33% marks in TEE-II (Feb/March) in a maximum of one subject in the final result, he / she would be given an opportunity to sit for a Compartment Examination.
- * The Compartment Examination shall be held only once with the same syllabus as for TEE-II and it shall be mandatory for a student to secure 33% marks in the same.
