Greetings from the Principal's Desk !!

We recognize that to be successful in school, our children need support from both home and school. We know a strong partnership with you will make a significant difference in your child's education. As partners, we share the responsibility for our children's success and want you to know that we will do our very best to carry out our responsibilities.

- **New Session commences for**
Classes I – XII – from April 02, 2024 (Tuesday) (For XI – Provisional Classes) and
Balwadi – from April 03, 2024 (Wednesday)
- **School Timing:** Balwadi : 9.00 am – 01.00 pm (Every Saturday will be holiday)
Class I – XII : 07.40 am – 01.50 pm (Every 2nd Saturday of the month will be holiday and every 4th Saturday of the month, school will get over after 6th period.)
- Late comers will be denied entry after 07:50 am.
- Transport facility is available for different routes.

Note:

In case you are availing school transport:

- Balwadi – Pick & drop facility from 03.04.2024 onwards will be provided.
- Classes I – XII : Pick & drop facility from 02.04.2024 onwards will be provided.
On the first day of school kindly do not panic if your ward reaches home a little late.

Uniform :

- Students should come in proper school uniform (Summer).
- Students of Classes I to XII will wear sports uniform on every Wednesday and Saturday.
- In case of non-availability of appropriate size of uniform student can wear : White Shirt / White T-Shirt and Blue/Black Jeans or pant.

IT IS NOT MANDATORY TO PURCHASE SCHOOL UNIFORM FROM SCHOOL TUCK SHOP.

- New class teacher will be introduced to you through old class teacher via official Whatsapp class group.
- Time table will be communicated by the new class teacher through Whatsapp group.
- Books to be sent according to the class time table. Extra books and notebooks to be kept at home.
- Students Scholar's Diary will be given to the students in the second week of April till then they can use a rough notebook for noting down homework.
- As the students will be attending morning assembly after a long time, therefore, it is requested to ask your ward to have breakfast before coming to school. (Don't send them empty stomach).
- A small box of fruits to be sent with students for Classes Balwadi to VIII along with their regular lunchbox.
- **Balwadi to V :** On Birthdays, children can wear causal dresses and bring only toffees / chocolates. They are not allowed to celebrate it in the form of a party or distributing expensive gifts.
Classes VI onwards only distribution of toffees is permitted.

The school has initiated new chapters of learning for academic enhancement & strengthening the overall development of students along with the bond of parents

- **Preparatory classes for competitive exams** : On Saturday's the school is going to prepare students for Olympiads, different competitions and academic support from Classes I to VIII.

Advance Academic Excellence Classes to enhance the performance of the students for Classes XI & XII aspiring to appear in exams like JEE, NEET, CUET etc.
- **Skill Subjects as per NEP** : CBSE has provided a number of Skill Subjects for Classes VI to XII. Our school provides the platform to avail the same.
- **Renewal Form** : A renewal form will be given to your ward carrying the Personal Details, Skill Subjects, Games, etc. The parents need to fill all those details carefully and submit it to the Class Teacher by April 05, 2024 in order to maintain the record of every child.
- Parents are requested not to approach the class teachers directly in the class on working days besides on PTM. All requests should be routed through the Scholars' Diary or with prior appointment.
